MINUTES FOR 03/08/05 Board of Alderman Town of Talty

I. Call to Order and Announce a Quorum

Mayor Weaver called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m. and announced a quorum. Absent were Alderman Donna Avery and Ginny Carter. The Planning and Zoning Committee announced a quorum.
