

Motion was not necessary, only discussion at this time. No vote was taken.

- XVI. The Board considered appointing the Town Administrator as the Deputy Early Voting Clerk. This requires someone being at Town Hall and posting election results once they are received.

Vote: All in favor. Motion carried.
- XVII. The Board discussed Dennis Wagner, previous Chief of Police, any possible monies due him. It was determined that Talty does not owe him any money and that a written request was made. The Town never received any correspondence from Dennis Wagner.
No vote was taken, no action necessary.
- XVIII. The Board discussed the Town Secretary position. The job was posted as required. Sherry Bagby addressed the Board suggesting strongly that a new position for Municipal Court Clerk be created to handle the huge amount of paperwork involved per each citation, prepare the various reports required by the State of Texas, filings involved with the violations, and to attend evening Court with Judge Ashcroft. This position would also fill-in as a back-up for the Town Secretary in her absence, to answer telephones and log permits.
Motion made to hire a municipal court clerk as a part-time position working from 8-noon, Monday through Friday, for a salary range of \$12 to \$15 per hour depending on court experience, legal experience, and level of education for the position. There would be a 90 day probationary period imposed.

Vote: All in favor. Motion carried.
- XIX. Updates on surrounding area of Talty. Mr. Goodwin showed a map of Talty's ETJ, which goes ½ mile around the town. A Municipal Utility District ("MUD") in Terrell is planning a 5,000 acre development with 12,000 lots for homes. This area would encompass the vacant land behind Emerald Ranch and against CR213-A, and behind some of Shamrock subdivisions. Mr. Goodwin and Mayor Carter have an upcoming meeting with the City Manager of Terrell. Mr. Goodwin recommends that Talty not give up any ETJ without something in return. He suggested negotiating for property along the I-20 corridor (the 496 mile marker) for commercial development with Terrell.
No vote was taken, no action necessary.
