

## Resolution No. 2003-50

### **A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF TALTY, TEXAS DESIGNATING OFFICIAL HOLIDAYS TO BE OBSERVED BY TOWN HALL AND OTHER TOWN SERVICES.**

**WHEREAS**, Federal and State legislators have designated certain official holidays to be observed, and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of Aldermen desires that the Town's officers, employees and citizens shall be allowed to observe and enjoy these holidays as well.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Talty, Texas:

**SECTION 1:** The following holidays shall be observed by the Town of Talty:

New Years Day	January 1
Martin Luther King's Birthday	Third Monday in January
Good Friday	Friday preceding Easter Sunday
Memorial Day	Last Monday in May
Independence Day	July 4
Labor Day	First Monday in September
Columbus Day	Second Monday in October
Veteran's Day	November 11
Thanksgiving Day	Fourth Thursday in November
Thanksgiving Friday	Fourth Friday in November
Christmas Eve	December 24
Christmas Day	December 25

**SECTION 2:** If any of the holidays fall on a Saturday, then the holiday shall be observed on the Friday immediately preceding the holiday. If any of the holidays fall on a Sunday, then the holiday shall be observed on the Monday immediately following the holiday.

**SECTION 3:** Town Hall and other Town services shall be closed in observance of these holidays.

**SECTION 4:** Observance of these holidays will commence immediately after the passage of this resolution.
