

**ORDINANCE NO. 2004-78**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF TALTY, TEXAS, CALLING FOR THE ELECTION OF THREE ALDERMEN; PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION JUDGES; PROVIDING FOR EARLY VOTING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen of the Town of Talty, Texas, hereby finds and determines that an election should be held to fill the positions of three (3) Aldermen; and that the term of office for the Aldermen shall be two years.

Now, Therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF TALTY, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** An election is hereby called for Saturday, May 15, 2004, such date being a uniform election date as defined in Section 41.004 of the Texas Election Code, as amended. At such election, the ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for up to three Aldermen.

**SECTION 2.** All qualified resident electors of the Town shall be permitted to vote at said election. This election shall be held and conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code.

**SECTION 3.** The polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day. The main polling place for the election shall be:

Trinity Family Church  
FM 1641 & Interstate 20, Talty

Early voting shall be held at Trinity Family Church located at FM 1641 & Interstate 20 in Talty from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday through Friday beginning April 28, 2004 through May 11,

2004.

**SECTION 4.** Mary Holubec and Mac McGinnis are hereby appointed to serve as Judge and Alternate Judge, respectively. These election officers are also appointed as the early voting ballot board for processing early voting ballots. The early voting clerk shall be the Town Secretary. The Election Judge may select one other registered voter within the Town to serve as election clerk on election day.

**SECTION 5.** A substantial copy of this ordinance shall serve as proper notice of said election. Said notice, including a Spanish translation thereof, shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation, published within the Town not earlier than the thirtieth day nor later than the tenth day before the election and posted not later than the twenty-first day before the election on the bulletin board used for publishing notices of the meetings of the Board of Aldermen of the Town.
