

The Talty City Council held their regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 p. m on Tuesday, January 18, 2022 at the Trinity Family Church, 9670 CR 214, located at the intersection of FM 1641 and I-20, on the following:

- I. <u>Call to Order</u>: Mayor Frank Garrison called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and announced a quorum. Those present were John Davis, Brad Davis, Judy Trevino, Bobby Crowley and Courtney McGrath.
- **II.** <u>Invocation</u>: All rose for the invocation by Brad Davis. Everyone recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

## **IV. Action Items:**

1. The Council considered Ordinance 2022-03 to provide the sale and issuance of general obligation refunding bonds, Series 2022 for the City of Talty regarding the capital improvement plan for streets. Andre Ayala, with Hilltop Securities, addressed the council and gave a hand-out. The interest rate of 1.863% from FHN Financial Capital Markets is a fixed through 2036. The Moody's Investment initial rating is A1, and allows Talty to get bond insurance. Closing and delivery of funds to the Escrow Agent will be February 10, 2022. It is recommended that we take the lowest bid.
