

MINUTES OF MAY 17, 2022 CITY COUNCIL MEETING

The Talty City Council held their regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 p. m on Tuesday, May 17, 2022 at the Trinity Family Church, 9670 CR 214, located at the intersection of FM 1641 and I-20, on the following:

- I. <u>Call to Order</u>: Mayor Frank Garrison called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and announced a quorum. Those present were John Davis, Judy Trevino, Courtney McGrath and Bobby Crowley. Brad Davis was absent.
- **II.** <u>Invocation</u>: All rose for the invocation by John Davis. Everyone recited the Pledge of Allegiance.
- III. Citizen Participation: No one signed in to speak to the Council.

Mabrey of JLM 717 Kaufman, LP for consent to include land in a political subdivision dated April 28, 2022. Mr. Mabrey was present to answer any questions for the council.
