

MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 15, 2022 CITY COUNCIL MEETING

The Talty City Council held their regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 p. m on Tuesday, November 15, 2022 at the Trinity Family Church, 107 Piedmont Path, located at the intersection of FM 1641 and I-20. Two public hearings were held prior to the beginning of their meeting on a Preliminary Plat for the Kingsborough Phase 1 subdivision, and on the proposed zoning amendments.

- I. <u>Call to Order</u>: Mayor Frank Garrison called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and announced a quorum. Council members present were John Davis, Judy Trevino, Courtney McGrath, Brad Davis and Bobby Crowley.
- II. Invocation and Pledge: All rose for the invocation by Brad Davis. All recited the pledge of Allegiance.

III. Public Hearings:

1. <u>Preliminary Plat for the Kingsborough Phase I.</u>

Mayor Garrison opened the public hearing at 7:02 p.m. for discussion on the Preliminary Plat for the Kingsborough Phase 1 subdivision, generally located in the City's extraterritorial jurisdiction on the north side of Evans Road within a 102.498 acre parcel, identified as 216134 on the Kaufman Central Appraisal District website. Talty's engineer, Carl Krogness, attended to answer questions and clarify concerns. Mayor Garrison closed the public hearing at 7:05 p.m.

2. <u>Proposed Zoning Amendments establishing off street parking and loading requirements and related illustrations.</u>

Mayor Garrison opened the public hearing at 7:06 p.m. on the proposed zoning amendments establishing off street parking and loading requirements and related illustrations. Mayor Garrison closed the public hearing at 7:10 p.m.

IV. Action Items:

1. Allison Weaver, on behalf of the Planning and Zoning Commission, made the recommendation to accept the Developer's 30 day extension to take action on the grounds to deny the request of the preliminary plat for the Kingsborough Phase 1 Subdivision, and to schedule a workshop on the subdivision ordinance requirements.

The Council discussed Talty's subdivision ordinance and the requirements that have not been met.

A Motion was made by Brad Davis to accept the Planning and Zoning Commission's recommendation to take up to 30 days to consider Kingsborough Phase 1 Subdivision preliminary plat, located in the extraterritorial jurisdiction on the north side of Evans Road within a 102.498 acre parcel [property I.D. 216134] on the Kaufman County Appraisal District.
