

ORDINANCE NO. 2022--08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALTY, TEXAS, CHANGING THE STREET NAME OF A PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD 214 FROM ITS PLACE OF INTERSECTION WITH FM 1641, WESTWARD TO THE PARCEL WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF THE CITY OF TALTY, TEXAS OWNED BY HARLAN PROPERTIES, PID 54114, TO "PIEDMONT PATH"; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Talty, Texas, has deemed it appropriate to change the name of a portion of County Road 214, a public street or highway in the territorial limits of the City, to "Piedmont Path," and such name change is deemed by the City Council to be in the best interest of the citizens. Now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TALTY, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That a certain designated part of County Road 214 be and is hereby changed such that henceforth that portion of said street shall be named "Piedmont Path."

The new name shall apply to the existing roadway described as follows:

Beginning on that part of County Road 214 at its place of intersection with FM 1641, extending in a western direction to the parcel within the territorial limits of the City of Talty, Texas owned by Harlan Properties, PID 54114, as shown in the attached Exhibit "A," which exhibit is incorporated herein and made a part hereof..

The City Manager is hereby directed to correct the maps and records of the City and the City's Thoroughfare Plan to reflect the change in street names herein, to cause appropriate signage to be erected, and to provide notice of the name change to all interested persons.

SECTION 2. That all provisions of the ordinances of the City of Talty, Texas, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That an offense committed before the effective date of this ordinance is governed by the prior law and provisions of the Code of Ordinances, as amended, in effect when the offense was committed and the former law is continued in effect for this purpose.

SECTION 4. That should any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance be for any reason held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid or unenforceable, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, clauses, or phrases of this ordinance as an entirety, it being the legislative intent that the provisions of this ordinance are severable and that the ordinance shall continue in effect notwithstanding the invalidity of such section, sentence, clause or phrase.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law and charter in such cases provide.
