

MINUTES OF MARCH 14, 2006
BOARD OF ALDERMEN
TOWN OF TALTY

The Board of Aldermen met in regular session on March 14, 2006, beginning at 7:00 p.m. at the Trinity Family Church in Talty, Texas. In attendance were Donna Avery, Mayor Earl Carter, Mark Graybill, Todd Hutton, Carla Milligan, and Connie Goodwin. Aldermen member absent was Brad Davis. Sherry Bagby, Town Secretary was also present.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Carter and a Quorum announced.

Most carriers would bill individual homeowners and Talty would not be responsible for payments to the trash carrier. Dick Demien, from IESI, addressed the Board and said if the Board decides to go with one carrier, he would like to have his company submit a bid. Mr. Goodwin stated that there were about 450 households in Talty. He said this contract would exclude the roll-offs for the builders. Mr. Chuck Eller, a homeowner in Winner's Circle, stated that by having only one trash carrier, it would penalize the homeowners in Phase I in the city limits of Talty, because some of Winner's Circle home are located in the ETJ and would not be required to adhere to the ordinance. Mayor Carter requested a price list from IESI. Mr. Goodwin stated that a standardized bid package would be sent to the four carriers in our area so that the bids would be comparable. Mr. Goodwin stated that he does not know of any complaints or concerns with the trash pickup from a public safety standpoint. Mark Graybill suggested that a letter be sent to the homeowners asking if they would like to have only one service.

No motion was made and no action taken since this was a discussion item only.

Motion was not necessary, only discussion at this time. No vote was taken.
