## **RESOLUTION NO. 2002 - 30**

A RESOLUTION REGARDING THE ANNEXATION PLAN FOR THE TOWN OF TALTY, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR EXCEPTIONS TO FILING AN ANNEXATION PLAN, PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS TO THE ANNEXATION PLAN AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 43.052 of the Texas Local Government Code requires that each city adopt an annexation plan to include territory the city plans to annex three years from the date the territory is placed in the plan;

WHEREAS, Section 43.052(h) of the Local Government Code provides several exceptions that authorize cities to annex territory without placing the territory in an annexation plan;

WHEREAS, annexations contemplated by the Town of Talty come within one or more of these exceptions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF TALTY:

That the Board of Aldermen has reviewed the future expansion needs of the Town and has determined that, at this time, the Town does not intend to annex any territory that is required to be in an annexation plan in order to be annexed. The Board of Aldermen reserves the right to amend the annexation plan in the future to add territory for annexation.

This annexation plan is approved this 12<sup>th</sup> day of November 2002 and will be effective on December 1, 2002.
